Chapter 2

RESOLVE, Opening Roxbury Pond, Oxford County, to Ice Fishing.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts and resolves passed by the legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the following legislation is necessary to permit ice fishing in Roxbury Pond during the winter of 1955; and

Whereas, such legislation is in the best interest of conserving our natural resources; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Roxbury Pond; open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation to open Roxbury Pond, Oxford county, to ice fishing.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 3

RESOLVE, in Favor of Norway Fish and Game Association for Fish Screen at Dam at Norway Lake.

Norway Fish and Game Association, reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$150 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the funds of the Department of Inland Fisheries and Game to Norway Fish and Game Association for the State's share for a steel fish screen at the dam at Norway Lake, the State's share having been paid by the Association.

Chapter 4

RESOLVE, in Favor of Herman Zimmerman of Presque Isle.

Herman Zimmerman; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$193.45 from the general highway fund of the State to be paid to Herman Zimmerman of Presque Isle, in settlement of his claim against the State for refund of tax for gasoline used for agricultural purposes.
