Chapter 85

RESOLVE, in Favor of Abigail D. Flynn, of Waldoboro.

Abigail D. Flynn; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$350 to be paid to Abigail D. Flynn, of Waldoboro, as a full and final settlement for her claim against the State, for reconstructing and replacing sewer of 130 feet, including the pipe and fittings, damage caused by the construction of the highway under the supervision of the State Highway Commission in March 1951; said amount to cover the expense of replacement of said sewer.

Chapter 86

RESOLVE, in Favor of Harold B. Gross, of Waldoboro.

Harold B. Gross; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$213.76 to be paid to Harold B. Gross, of Waldoboro, as a full and final settlement for his claim against the State, for the cost of replacement of sewer damaged in March 1951, by construction of highway on Route 220, said sewer leading from the former hotel property of James Duanne to the Maine Water Company sewer.

Chapter 87

RESOLVE, Classifying Road from Rockwood to Jackman as State Highway.

Road from Rockwood to Jackman classified. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to classify State Aid Highway No. 15 running from Rockwood to Jackman, Somerset county, as a State Highway.

Chapter 88

RESOLVE, Providing for Survey of Railroad Crossings on College Avenue and Front Street in City of Waterville.

Survey of railroad crossings in Waterville; provided for. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a survey and study for the elimination of railroad grade crossings on College Avenue and Front Street in the City of Waterville.
