CHAP. 105

The daily bag limit is 15 trout, salmon, togue or bass in the aggregate from any or all of the lakes, ponds, rivers, streams and brooks, which shall not exceed a weight of $7\frac{1}{2}$ pounds in the aggregate unless otherwise restricted below.

No size or bag limits on white perch.

Boulter Pond, York. Closed.

Chase's Pond, York. Closed.

Deer Pond, Hollis. Daily limit 5 trout.

Ell Pond, Sanford and Wells. Use or possession of live fish as bait prohibited. Daily limit 5 fish.

Folly Pond, York. Closed.

Goose Pond, Shapleigh. No size or bag limits on pickerel and bass. Open season and means of taking bass corresponds to general law on trout and salmon.

Littlefield Pond, Sanford. Closed.

Lone Pond, Waterboro. Fly fishing only. Daily limit 5 fish.

Middle Pond, York. Closed.

Milliken's Mill Pond and Tributaries, Old Orchard Beach. Fly fishing only. Daily limit 5 trout.

Mousam Lake, Acton and Shapleigh. No size or bag limits on pickerel and bass. Open season and means of taking bass corresponds to general law on trout and salmon. Tributaries closed to taking of smelts.

Ossipee Pond, Little, Waterboro. No size or bag limits on pickerel and bass. Open season and means of taking bass corresponds to general law on trout and salmon.

Round Pond, Lyman. Fly fishing only. Daily limit 5 trout.

Square Pond, Acton and Shapleigh. No size or bag limits on pickerel and bass. Open season and means of taking bass corresponds to general law on trout and salmon.

Warren Pond, South Berwick. Use or possession of live fish as bait prohibited. Daily limit 5 fish.

Effective August 20, 1955

Chapter 105

RESOLVE, to Simplify the Ice Fishing Laws by Counties.

Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game to issue certain rules and regulations. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is here-

by authorized and directed to issue rules and regulations relating to ice fishing in certain lakes, ponds, rivers, streams and brooks. Where county lines divide a body of water the more liberal county regulations shall apply.

ANDROSCOGGIN COUNTY

The daily bag limit is 15 trout, salmon, togue or bass in the aggregate from any or all of the lakes, ponds, rivers, streams and brooks which shall not exceed a weight of 7½ pounds in the aggregate unless otherwise restricted below.

No size or bag limit on white perch.

Open to ice fishing for pickerel, white perch, hornpout, yellow perch, eels, cusk, chubs and smelts from the time ice forms in the fall until March 31.

Chapter 106

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Setting Out of Buoys in Sebago Lake.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the waters of Sebago Lake are used by many boats of all sizes; and

Whereas, only a portion of the dangerous areas of the lake are now marked; and

Whereas, another year's delay in completing the project of designating the dangerous areas will constitute a hazard to life and limb; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Buoying of Sebago Lake Authorized. Resolved: That the Public Utilities Commission be, and hereby is, authorized to permit any interested person or persons to set out in Sebago Lake, Cumberland County, properly marked buoys in such places where in the opinion of the Public Utilities Commission a hazard to boating exists; such setting out to be under the supervision and direction of the Public Utilities Commission.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Resolve shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 107

RESOLVE, Designating Part of Route No. 9 as State Highway.

State Highway Number 9, designated. Resolved: That the State Highway Commission be and hereby is authorized and directed to designate that part of Route No. 9 commencing at the junction of Route No. 137 in Albion, Kennebec County, and extending to the junction of Route No. 1 in Hampden, Penobscot County, as a State highway; and be it further
