Chapter 151

RESOLVE, in Favor of Francis Coyne of Westbrook for Damage by Escapees from Reformatory for Men.

Francis Coyne; reimbursed. **Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund the sum of \$75 to be paid to Francis Coyne, of Westbrook, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done by two escapees from the Reformatory for Men, on April 21, 1954 to a 1937 Chevrolet sedan owned by Mr. Coyne.

Chapter 152

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Roscoe Morse of Rockland for Damage by Escaped Prisoner of State Prison.

Roscoe Morse; reimbursed. **Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$100 to be paid to Roscoe Morse, of Rockland, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his 1953 Willys, by another car the operator of which was an escaped prisoner of the Maine State Prison.

Chapter 153

RESOLVE, Providing for the Payment of Certain Pauper Claims.

Claims, appropriation and payment of. **Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund, to be paid to the cities, towns, counties and persons hereinafter named, the sums set opposite their respective names, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of \$12,070.66, being a full and final settlement of all claims against the State of Maine, as follows:
