Chapter 154**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Bingham.**

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$222.62 to be paid to the town of Bingham for reimbursement of expenses incurred by the town of Bingham for the use of the town of Bingham's fire equipment and personnel to combat fires during the year 1953, in the township of Concord.

Chapter 155**RESOLVE, in Favor of Raymond Butler of New Gloucester.**

Raymond Butler; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the state the sum of \$30.23 to be paid to Raymond Butler of New Gloucester, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State, for damage done to his truck by boys from the Pownal State School.
