Chapter 248

AN ACT Relating to Persons Qualified to Serve as Jurors.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 116, § 4, amended. Section 4 of chapter 116 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new sentence, to read as follows:

'No person shall be qualified or selected for jury service who has served as such at any term of the Superior Court held within 3 years next preceding the re-selection of said person by the jury commissioners.'

Chapter 249

AN ACT Relating to Reciprocal Agreements with New Hampshire Concerning Zonal Operation of Commercial Vehicles in Intrastate Commerce.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 69-A, additional. Chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 69-A, to read as follows:

'Reciprocal Agreements with New Hampshire.

Sec. 69-A. Reciprocal agreements with New Hampshire. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, the Secretary of State is empowered to make agreements or arrangements with the duly authorized representatives of the state of New Hampshire providing that trucks, tractors or semi-trailers owned by residents of such bordering state and legally registered in such state may be operated in intrastate commerce in this State within a zone not to exceed 10 miles from the border of such state. Such agreements or arrangements shall provide that a resident of this State, when using the highways of said adjoining state, shall receive substantially equivalent benefits and privileges.'
