Chapter 251

AN ACT Relating to Date of State Convention.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 4, § 16, amended. The 1st sentence of section 16 of chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~'Not less than 60 nor more than 90 days before~~ Not more than 90 days before or not more than 30 days after the 3rd Monday in June of each year in which a biennial state election is to be held, each political party shall hold a state convention with such basis of representation and at such time and place and with such requisites as to call and notice therefor as the state committee of each such political party may determine.'

Sec. 2. R. S., c. 4, § 16, amended. The 5th sentence of section 16 of chapter 4 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 349 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

~~'The chairman and vice-chairman of the state committee may be chosen from within or without the membership of the state committee and shall be chosen as soon as possible after the 15th day of May next following the state convention.'~~

Chapter 252

AN ACT Relating to Compensation for Eye Impairment Under Workmen's Compensation Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 31, § 13, amended. The 4th paragraph from the end of section 13 of chapter 31 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'For the loss of an eye, or the reduction of the sight of an eye, with glasses, to 1/10 of the normal vision, or for diplopia, 100 weeks.'

AN ACT to Correct Inconsistencies in State Prison Sentences.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 149, § 11, amended. The last sentence of section 11 of chapter 149 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
