Chapter 257

AN ACT Relating to Splash Guards for Motor Trucks.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 22, § 141-A, amended. Section 141-A of chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 339 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 141-A. Splash guards. Every motor truck, trailer and semi-trailer operated in or upon any way shall be equipped with suitable guards which will effectively reduce the spray or splash to the rear of mud, water or slush caused by the rear wheels thereof, except that such guards shall not be required on any truck:

I. With a gross registered weight of 14,000 pounds or less; or

II. To dump trucks while working on construction or reconstruction projects in the area under construction; or

III. To a truck tractor when not hauling a trailer or semi-trailer.

The provisions of this section shall not apply to fire department vehicles.'

Chapter 258

AN ACT Relating to Display of Maine Alcoholic Beverage Products in State Liquor Stores.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 61, § 8, sub-§ V-A, additional. Section 8 of chapter 61 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapters 294 and 401 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended by adding thereto a new subsection to be numbered V-A, to read as follows:

'V-A. The Commission shall display in state stores, authorized under the provisions of sections 10 and 11, a separate list of all alcoholic beverage products manufactured or bottled in this State and listed by the Commission, suitably marked to indicate that the same are Maine products. Such display shall be in addition to the regular listing of all the products sold by the Commission.'
