Chapter 276

AN ACT Relating to Disposition of License Fees in the Bee Industry.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 32, § 174, amended. The last sentence of section 174 of chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

'Such license fees shall accrue to the general fund.'

Chapter 277

AN ACT Relating to Rehabilitation and Preservation of Covered Bridges.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., c. 23, § 126-A, additional. Chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 126-A, to read as follows:

'Covered Bridges.

Sec. 126-A. Covered bridges. Upon application by the municipal officers of a municipality responsible for maintenance of a covered wooden bridge on a public highway, the State Highway Commission is authorized to perform such maintenance and rehabilitation work as it considers necessary and practicable for preservation of the structure.'

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is hereby appropriated from the general highway fund the sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 and \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959 to carry out the purposes of this act.
