Chapter 286

AN ACT Relating to Elections in Towns.

Effective August 28, 1957

Chapter 287

AN ACT Relating to the Maine Forestry District.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 36, § 96, amended. The 1st sentence of section 96 of chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 13 of the public laws of 1955, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'A tax of 4 3/4 mills on the dollar is assessed upon all the property in the Maine Forestry District, including rights in public reserved lots, to be used for the protection thereof; except that in organized municipalities the tax rate shall be 4 3/4 mills multiplied by a fraction whose numerator is the previous year's assessed value of the land taxable by the municipality, including dams and power houses but not including any other structure or building, and whose denominator shall be the total previous year's assessed value of all property taxable by the municipality.'

Chapter 288

AN ACT Relating to Employees of Maine Maritime Academy Receiving Federal Social Security Benefits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 65, § 1, amended. The last sentence of section 1 of chapter 65 of the Revised Statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Provided, however, that the The provisions of this chapter shall also apply to employees of the University of Maine and Maine Maritime Academy who are members of an existing retirement or pension system.'
