**Referendum; effective date; certificates to Secretary of State.** This act shall take effect 90 days after adjournment of the Legislature, only for the purpose of permitting its submission to the legal voters of the town of Bridgton and of said Bridgton Centre Village Corporation at regular meetings thereof held within one year after the effective date of this act, provided that the warrants calling such meetings contain appropriate articles for that purpose. Such meetings shall be called and conducted according to the law governing municipal elections, except that the board of registration of said town and the assessors of said Bridgton Centre Village Corporation shall not be required to prepare for posting, nor the town clerk or the clerk of said Bridgton Centre Village Corporation to post, another list of voters. The town clerk of the town of Bridgton and the clerk of the Bridgton Centre Village Corporation shall prepare proper ballots, upon which the subject matter of this act shall be reduced to the following question: "Shall the Act to Repeal Incorporation of Bridgton Centre Village Corporation and Incorporating Bridgton Water District, passed by the 98th Legislature, be accepted?" and the voters of said town and of said corporation shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. This act shall become fully effective on the 1st Monday in March next following the date that certificates of the result of each vote is filed with the Secretary of State to the effect that this act is accepted by both the inhabitants of the town of Bridgton and the Bridgton Centre Village Corporation, but only if the total number of votes cast for and against the acceptance of this act in said town meeting equals or exceeds 20% of the total vote for all candidates for Governor cast in said town at the next preceding gubernatorial election.

The result of the vote shall be declared by the municipal officers of said town and by the assessors of said corporation, and a certificate of the result of the vote shall be filed by the clerk of said town and by the clerk of said Bridgton Centre Village Corporation with the Secretary of State.

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## Chapter 90

### AN ACT Designating a Certain Road as "Mt. Katahdin Trail"

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

"Mt. Katahdin Trail," designated. The following described highway is hereby designated as the "Mt. Katahdin Trail": Beginning in Newport at the junction of Route U. S. 2 and Route 7, extending to Dover-Foxcroft over Route 7; thence to Milo by Route 16, to Millinocket by Route 11 and the Brownville-Millinocket road, so called; thence to Baxter State Park over the "Baxter State Park Road." Signs designating this as the "Mt. Katahdin Trail" shall be erected by the State Highway Commission at proper intervals along the highway.
