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## Chapter 12

### RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Middle Chain Lake and Upper Chain Lake, Hancock County.

Middle Chain lake, Upper Chain lake; regulating ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the following lakes to fishing under the general ice fishing regulations for Hancock county from ice in to March 31:

Middle Chain Lake, T4, Hancock county.

Upper Chain Lake, T4, Hancock county.

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## Chapter 13

### RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing on Lake Christopher, Oxford County.

Lake Christopher; regulating ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Lake Christopher, Oxford county, to ice fishing for all fish except bass during February and March.

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## Chapter 14

### RESOLVE, to Study Advisability of State Office Building in Bangor.

State office building in Bangor; study advisability. Resolved: That the Bureau of Public Improvements of the Department of Finance and Administration be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to make a study of the need and cost of a State office building in Bangor for the purpose of determining whether state governmental activities would be materially improved as a result of relocation and centralization of certain departmental functions personally conducted in that area; and be it further

Resolved: That the Bureau shall report the result of its study to the next Legislature.
