## Chapter 53

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Grand Lake Stream, Washington County.
Grand Lake Stream; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Grand Lake Stream to fishing for salmon, trout, togue and white perch in waters free of ice from April ist until September 15 th.

## Chapter 54

RESOLVE, Regulating Ice Fishing in Pleasant Lake, Aroostook County.
Pleasant lake; open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Pleasant lake, Island Falls, T4, R3, Aroostook county, to ice fishing from February i to March 3I.

## Chapter 55

RESOLVE, Opening Chemquasabamticook Lake, Piscataquis County, to Ice Fishing.

Chemquasabamticook lake; open to ice fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Chemquasabamticook lake, T9, RI5 and Tio, Ri5, in Piscataquis county, to ice fishing during February and March.

## Chapter 56

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Milliken's Mill Pond and Tributaries, York County.

Milliken's Mill pond and tributaries; open to fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Milliken's Mill pond and tributaries, Old Orchard Beach, York county, to fishing under the general laws of York county, with a daily bag limit of 5 trout.
