Chapter 91

RESOLVE, Charging off Funds Advanced to Maine State Office Building Authority.

Funds; charged off. Resolved: That the State Controller be, and hereby is, authorized to charge off \$286,045.04, which was advanced to the Maine State Office Building Authority in accordance with chapter 76 of the private and special laws of 1941, as amended by chapter 51 of the private and special laws of 1945.

Effective August 28, 1957

Chapter 92

RESOLVE, Relating to Construction of a Road and Terminal in City of Rockland.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, under the provisions of chapter 176 of the resolves of 1951, and chapter 129 of the resolves of 1955, certain state moneys were appropriated for a road and terminal in the city of Rockland and such appropriation was to be available until June 30, 1957; and

Whereas, Federal funds have been appropriated for a survey of the harbor at Rockland; and

Whereas, it is deemed vital by the Legislature that the survey should be completed before any state moneys are expended; and

Whereas, it is vitally necessary to extend the time during which the state moneys are available beyond June 30, 1957; and

Whereas, acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Resolves, 1951, c. 176, amended. Resolved: The 5th and 6th paragraphs of chapter 176 of the resolves of 1951, as enacted by chapter 129 of the resolves of 1955, are hereby amended to read as follows:

'That, in addition to the \$50,000 appropriated by the 4th paragraph, an additional sum up to \$50,000 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the unappropriated surplus of the general fund for the same purposes, to be available until June 30, \frac{1957}{1959}.
