RESOLVES, 1957

Chapter 104

RESOLVE, in Favor of Martin Brothers of Van Buren.

Martin Brothers; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$42 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to Martin Brothers of Van Buren to reimburse them for coal delivered to Louis Chasse, a State Ward; said sum to be paid from the general fund of the State.

Effective August 28, 1957

Chapter 105

RESOLVE, in Favor of Town of Milo for Aid to Emile Thibodeau.

Town of Milo; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$152.37 to be paid to the town of Milo to reimburse it for aid given to Emile Thibodeau.

Effective August 28, 1957

Chapter 106

RESOLVE, in Favor of Norman M. Dyer of Ellsworth.

Norman M. Dyer; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$72 to be paid to Norman M. Dyer, of Ellsworth, to reimburse him for fuel supplies given to Charles Hodgkins of Ellsworth, a State pauper.

Chapter 107

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Limestone for Aid Extended to Marion Joseph of Limestone.

Town of Limestone; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$191.55 to be paid to the town of Limestone to reimburse said town for aid given to Marion Joseph of Limestone.
