### Chapter 146

RESOLVE, Providing for Judicial Review of Certain Criminal Judgments.

Judicial review of certain criminal judgments; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1958 and \$5,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1959 to be added to the general appropriation for the operation of the Supreme Judicial and Superior Courts. Said sum to be used to defray the cost of operating a system of judicial review of judgments in criminal cases involving felonies for indigent persons who are unable to pay for such review under rules as the Supreme Judicial Court shall from time to time determine to be necessary for the protection of such persons' constitutional rights.

### Chapter 147

#### **RESOLVE** to Reimburse Town of Whiting, Washington County.

Town of Whiting; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the general fund of the State the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to the town of Whiting to reimburse it for repairs to the school heating plant.
