PUBLIC LAWS, 1959

has been abated. Licenses issued from January 1st through August 31st shall require evidence of the payment of the previous year's poll tax, and licenses, issued from September 1st through December 31st shall require evidence of the payment of the current year's poll tax.'

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this act shall take effect when approved.

Chapter 85

AN ACT Relating to Part Payment of Delinquent Property Taxes in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 16, § 84, amended. Section 84 of chapter 16 of the Revised Statutes is amended by inserting after the first paragraph a new paragraph, as follows:

'Part payments accepted during the redemption period shall not interrupt or extend the redemption period or in any way affect the foreclosure proceedings. If the total amount necessary for redemption is not paid before the mortgage is foreclosed, the mortgagor shall be entitled to a refund of such part payments made after the filing of the certificate provided for in section 83.'

Chapter 86

AN ACT Clarifying Name of Federal Law Relating to Federal Highway Funds.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 23, § 15, amended. The first sentence of section 15 of chapter 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

'The provisions of the Federal Aid Road Act (public number 156) entitled "An Act to Provide that the United States shall aid the states in the construction of Rural Post Roads and for other purposes," approved July 11, 1916 "Title 23, United States Code," and all other acts amendatory thereof and supplementary thereto, are assented to.'
