Chapter 186

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys to Effectuate Pay Plan for State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Appropriation for Proposed Salary Plan. There is hereby appropriated from the General Fund of the State the sum of \$1,000,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960, to effectuate, as of the first pay period ending in January 1960, the Recommended Revised Pay Plan of the State Personnel Board dated January 1959. The above appropriated funds are for both classified and unclassified positions in the General Fund. Any balance at June 30, 1960 shall not lapse but shall carry forward into the 1960-61 fiscal year to be used for the same purpose.

Sec. 2. Unclassified Employees subject to Governor and Council determination. With respect to unclassified employees whose wage rates are subject to Governor and Council determination, the Governor and Council are requested to consider such similar and equitable treatment as they may conclude is appropriate.

Sec. 2-A. Unclassified Employees not subject to Governor and Council determination. With respect to unclassified employees whose wage rates are not subject to determination by the Governor and Council, the authority responsible for determining the wage rate of such employees are requested to consider such similar and equitable treatment as they may conclude is appropriate.

Sec. 3. Utilization by Other Funds. Wages of employees in departments supported by the Highway Fund, Special Revenue Funds or Other Funds shall not be adjusted from moneys provided for the General Fund Pay Plan, but may be adjusted from funds available to the department from other sources.

Sec. 4. Intent. It is the intent of the Legislature to adjust the ranges of the State salary schedule to reflect competitive wages as indicated in the State Personnel Board's—Recommended Revised Pay Plan—dated January 1959.
