## Chapter 18

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Moosehead Lake, Piscataquis County.

**Moosehead Lake; fishing regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to ice fishing that part of Moosehead Lake from the mouth of Williams Brook in Big W. Township to a straight line between 2 yellow posts, one set on the land of Hermon Brautigam on the south shore of Williams Cove and the other in a northeasterly direction on the opposite shore, Piscataquis County.

## Chapter 19

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Sawyer Pond, Piscataquis County.

**Fishing in Sawyer Pond; regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait and establishing a 5 trout daily bag limit in Sawyer Pond, Greenville Twp., Piscataquis County.

## Chapter 20

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in the West Branch of Pleasant River, Piscataquis County.

**Fishing in the West Branch of Pleasant River; regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the West Branch of the Pleasant River in Piscataquis County to fishing under the general law, except there shall be a daily bag limit of 10 trout in that portion of the river from the Gulf Hagus to First West Branch Pond.

## Chapter 21

### RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Lily Lake, Washington County.

**Fishing in Lily Lake regulated. Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 trout and prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait on Lily Lake, in Trescott, Washington County.
