Chapter 67

RESOLVE, Relating to Determination of Damages Caused by Taking of Land for Highway Purposes.

Procedures relating to determination of damages; study of. **Resolved:** That the Legislative Research Committee be authorized to study the procedures relating to determination of damages caused by the taking of land for highway purposes and report to the 100th Legislature.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 68

RESOLVE, Opening County Road Lake in Aroostook County to Ice Fishing.

Fishing in County Road Lake, regulated. **Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening County Road Lake, New Limerick Township, Aroostook County, to ice fishing under the general laws from ice in to March 31st.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 69

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing on Deer Meadow Pond in Lincoln County.

Fishing on Deer Meadow Pond, regulated. **Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation establishing a daily bag limit of 5 trout on Deer Meadow Pond, Jefferson Township, Lincoln County.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 70

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Horne Pond, Limington, York County.

Fishing in Horne Pond; regulated. **Resolved:** That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Horne Pond in Limington, York County, to ice fishing from the time ice forms in the fall until March 31st, for all fish except bass, salmon and trout.
