Chapter 80

RESOLVE, in Favor of Lena Freyer of Covington, Kentucky.

Lena Freyer; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$750 to be paid to Lena Freyer, of Covington, Kentucky, as a full and final settlement of her claim against the State for serious personal injury and property damage, sustained on July 11, 1957, in the collision of her husband's automobile with the improperly secured draw of the Mount Desert Bridge, controlled and operated by the State Highway Commission.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 81

RESOLVE, in Favor of George Freyer, Jr. of Covington, Kentucky.

George Freyer, Jr.; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$750 to be paid to George Freyer, Jr., of Covington, Kentucky, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for serious personal injury and property damage sustained on July 11, 1957, in the collision of his automobile with the improperly secured draw of the Mount Desert Bridge, controlled and operated by the State Highway Commission.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 82

RESOLVE, in Favor of Lloyd Moore of Gouldsboro.

Lloyd Moore; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$500 to be paid to Lloyd Moore, of Gouldsboro, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to a well on his property caused by the construction on State Highway Project #F-044-1 (3) in Gouldsboro.

Effective September 12, 1959

Chapter 83

RESOLVE, in Favor of A. R. Palmer of Litchfield.

A. R. Palmer; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$500 to be paid to A. R. Palmer, of Litchfield, as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage, not compensated by the State Highway Commission, to a well on his property caused by salt used by the State Highway Commission on route 197 in Litchfield.

Effective September 12, 1959
