Resolved: That the Committee be authorized to employ such expert and professional advisors and counsel and such clerical and office personnel as in its judgment it may determine within the limits of funds provided; and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$25,000 be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund, and that any balance of this fund as of June 30, 1960 shall not lapse but be carried forward into the 1960-1961 year to be used for the same purpose; and be it further

Resolved: That any donation from any individual, foundation or corporation may be accepted by the Committee and used for the purposes of this resolve.

Chapter 92

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Town of Oakfield for Aid to Family of Leo Cote.

Town of Oakfield; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund of the State the sum of \$3,251.25 to be paid to the Town of Oakfield to reimburse it for aid given to family of Leo Cote.

Chapter 93

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Howland.

Town of Howland; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,523.94 to be paid to the Town of Howland to reimburse said town for aid extended to Priscilla Leeman.

Chapter 94

RESOLVE, In Favor of Leonore A. Kenniston of Amherst.

Leonore A. Kenniston; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$1,500 to be paid to Leonore A. Kenniston, of Amherst, as a full and final settlement of her claim against the State for loss of her home in New Gloucester, Maine, caused by an escapee from the Pineland Hospital and Training Center.
