Chapter 106

RESOLVE, Creating a Committee on the Uniform Commercial Code.

Committee on the Uniform Commercial Code. Resolved: That a committee composed of 3 members of the Bar shall be appointed by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Judicial Court to arrange for the preparation of the necessary repealing and amendatory provisions of the Revised Statutes, and the annotations thereto, to conform to the Uniform Commercial Code; and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$2,500 be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to carry out the provisions of this resolve.

Chapter 107

RESOLVE, To Purchase Fifty Copies of "History of Otisfield."

Copies of "History of Otisfield"; purchased. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$625 for the State to purchase 50 copies of the book entitled "History of Otisfield," written by William S. Spurr, at \$12.50 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

RESOLVE, For the Purchase of Fifty Copies of "A History of the Town of Porter, Maine."

Purchase copies of "A History of the Town of Porter, Maine;" appropriation for. Resolved: That the State purchase 50 copies of the book entitled "A History of the Town of Porter, Maine," written by William Teg, Ph. D., at \$5 per copy; said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$250 for this purpose.

RESOLVE, to Purchase Fifty Copies of "A History of Aurora, Maine."

"A History of Aurora, Maine;" purchase of. Resolved: That the State purchase from the Town of Aurora 50 copies of "A History of Aurora, Maine,"

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written by Herbert T. Silsby, II, at a price not exceeding \$5 per copy, said books to be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian; and be it further

Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$250 for this purpose.

Chapter 110

RESOLVE, Appropriating Moneys for Restoration of Certain Forts in Aroostook County.

Restoration of certain forts in Aroostook County; appropriation. **Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$5,000 to Aroostook County for restoration of the following forts in Aroostook County:

Fort Fairfield at Fort Fairfield;

Fort Kent at Fort Kent;

Hancock Barracks at Houlton.

The expenditure of the appropriation shall be under the supervision of the county commissioners of Aroostook County. Any unexpended balances shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1961.

RESOLVE Providing for Biographical Sketches of Maine Composers.

Biographical sketches of Maine composers; appropriation for. **Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1960, the sum of \$750, to the State Library for distribution to all libraries in Maine of a booklet containing the biographical sketches of Maine composers and their compositions, to be published by the Maine Federation of Music Clubs.
