Chapter 127

RESOLVE In Favor of a Survivor Benefit Allowance for Otelia M. Race of Guilford.

Otelia M. Race; survivor benefit allowance. Resolved: That Richard J. Race, late of Guilford, be given credit for $3\frac{1}{2}$ years of teaching service rendered in Vermont, so that Otelia M. Race of Guilford, his widow, may be eligible for a survivor benefit allowance based on $17\frac{1}{2}$ years of teaching service by Mr. Race. The Maine State Retirement System shall retain \$250 of the amount Mr. Race paid into the system on account of out-of-state service, covering the $3\frac{1}{2}$ years credit hereby granted, and the balance of the amount shall be refunded to Otelia M. Race.
