Chapter 1

AN ACT Relating to Appointment of Baxter State Park Agents and Representatives.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 36, § 43-A, additional. Chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 43-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 43-A. Agents and representatives. The Baxter State Park Authority shall appoint agents or representatives to carry out sections 42 to 47. All appointed agents or representatives shall hold office under the rules of the Personnel Law. They shall be sworn to the faithful discharge of their duties and a certificate thereof shall be returned and filed in the office of the chairman of the authority. They shall receive such compensation for each and every day as determined by the authority, with approval of the State Personnel Board, with allowance for actual necessary expenses of travel.'

Chapter 2

AN ACT Relating to Having Weapons in Motor Vehicles for Hunting.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37, § 78, amended. The 4th sentence of section 78 of chapter 37 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended to read as follows:
