Chapter 112

AN ACT Relating to First Baptist Church of Kittery Point.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

The First Baptist Society in the Town of Kittery; proceeding ratified; name changed. The name of the "First Baptist Society in the Town of Kittery," incorporated by an act of the Massachusetts General Court in 1811 and in continuous existence since, is hereby changed to "First Baptist Church of Kittery Point" and all proceedings of said society, which has variously been known as "The Free Will Baptist Society of Kittery Point in the State of Maine," "The Free Will Baptist Society of Kittery," "Kittery First Free Will Society," "Free Will Baptist Society, Kittery," "Kittery Second Baptist Society," "Free Will Baptist Society of Kittery Point," and "Kittery Free Will Baptist Church and Society, Kittery Point," are hereby ratified and made legal and said corporation is authorized to hold title to all and any real estate.

Chapter 113

AN ACT to Ratify the Incorporation of Pierce Cemetery Association.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Pierce Cemetery Association; incorporation ratified. The incorporation of Pierce Cemetery Association, in the County of Somerset, State of Maine, on the 26th day of October, 1917 is ratified and it is declared that this corporation is in existence and has been in existence since its incorporation. The register of deeds in and for the County of Somerset is authorized and instructed to enter upon his records this validation of the incorporation of Pierce Cemetery Association in accordance with this act. The Secretary of State is authorized and instructed to enter upon his records the certificate of organization of Pierce Cemetery Association.

It is further declared that the duly elected treasurer of Pierce Cemetery Association is authorized to withdraw, from time to time, so much of the dividends declared upon the following savings accounts, as hereinafter listed, as is necessary for the perpetual care of the cemetery lots of the deceased persons mentioned in these specific funds:

Chapter 114

AN ACT Relating to Limitation on Lien on Nursing Home in Town of Madawaska.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1957, c. 211, amended. Chapter 211 of the private and special laws of 1957, as amended by chapter 89 of the private and special laws of 1959, is further amended to read as follows:

'Madawaska to raise money for nursing home. The Town of Madawaska, Aroostook County, may raise or appropriate money to provide for or support a nursing home in the Town of Madawaska for the hospitalization or nursing care of aged human beings, provided that said nursing home shall be organized
