Chapter 27

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Bugeye Pond, Franklin County.

Bugeye Pond; regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Bugeye Pond in Kibby Township, Franklin County, to fishing under the general law and prohibiting the use or possession of live fish as bait.

Effective September 16, 1961

Chapter 28

RESOLVE, Designating Bridge Between Livermore and Livermore Falls as "Livermore - Livermore Falls Veterans Bridge."

Bridge between Livermore and Livermore Falls designated. Resolved: That the bridge between Livermore and Livermore Falls, Androscoggin County, be officially named and referred to as "Livermore-Livermore Falls Veterans Bridge."

Effective September 16, 1961

Chapter 29

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Wiggin Brook, Piscataquis County.

Wiggin Brook; regulating fishing. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Wiggin Brook in Greenville and T. 3, R. 5, Piscataquis County, to fishing under the general law to all persons under the age of 17 years.

Chapter 30

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Roach River, Piscataquis County.

Fishing in Roach River, Piscataquis County, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be, and is, authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Roach River or Kokadjo River, in the Township of Kokadjo, Piscataquis County, to fly fishing only from September 1st to September 15th.
