RESOLVES, 1961

CHAP. 98

"Shall the Constitution be amended as proposed by a resolution of the Legislature providing that the funds of the Maine State Retirement System shall be maintained in trust and shall not be diverted?"

The inhabitants of said cities, towns and plantations shall vote by ballot on said question, and shall indicate by a cross or check mark placed against the words "Yes" or "No" their opinion of the same. The ballots shall be received, sorted, counted and declared in open ward, town and plantation meetings and returns made to the office of the Secretary of State in the same manner as votes for Governor and Members of the Legislature, and the Governor and Council shall count the same, and if it shall appear that a majority of the inhabitants voting on the question are in favor of the amendment, the Governor shall forthwith make known the fact by his proclamation, and the amendment shall thereupon, as of the date of said proclamation, become a part of the Constitution.

Secretary of State shall prepare ballots. Resolved: That the Secretary of State shall prepare and furnish to the several cities, towns and plantations ballots and blank returns in conformity with the foregoing resolve, accompanied by a copy thereof.

Chapter 96

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Canton Water District for Damage from Highway Construction.

Canton Water District; reimbursed. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$195.22 to reimburse Canton Water District for damage done to a water main during highway construction.

Chapter 97

RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds to Complete Survey for a Maine-Quebec Highway.

Survey for Maine-Quebec highway; additional appropriation. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$700 to be expended under direction and supervision of the State Highway Commission to complete the survey authorized by Resolves of 1959, chapter 84, for a highway from Ashland to the Quebec border at a point near d'Aaquan, P. Q.

Chapter 98

RESOLVE in Favor of Richard S. Foster, of York.

Richard S. Foster; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$474.50 to reimburse Richard S. Foster, of
