CHAP. 112

Chapter 110

RESOLVE, in Favor of Maine Society of the Sons of the American Revolution.

Maine Society of the Sons of the American Revolution; appropriation. Resolved: There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$200 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 for the purpose of procuring testimonials to be used in marking the unmarked graves of the soldiers of the Revolutionary War; and be it further

Resolved: That with the approval of the Governor and Council, said sum shall be paid into the treasury of the "Maine Society of the Sons of the American Revolution," with which they are authorized to procure and distribute such number of markers as may, from time to time, be required for the purposes herein specified.

Chapter 111

RESOLVE, in Favor of Walter Lanoue of Limerick.

Walter Lanoue; compensated. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$350 to be paid to Walter Lanoue of Limerick for damage to his house by the State Police in pursuing an alleged criminal.

Chapter 112

RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Advisory Committee on Education.

Advisory Committee on Education; appropriation. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$4,258 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1962 and \$4,258 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1963 for secretarial and other expenses of the Advisory Committee on Education.
