report of investigation is not submitted to the court within the time allowed, then the court may proceed with hearing upon the petition without such report. The aforesaid notification and investigation may be waived by the court and the reason therefor shall be stated in writing by the court and made a part of the record.'

#### Chapter 315

AN ACT Relating to Purchase of Lands by Atlantic Sea Run Salmon Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 37-A, § 19-A, additional. Chapter 37-A of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 331 of the public laws of 1959, is amended by adding a new section 19-A, to read as follows:

'Sec. 19-A. Authority to purchase lands, build dams, etc. The salmon commission is authorized to purchase or lease, within this State, lands, dams and other structures, to acquire flowage rights, mill privileges and rights-of-way, and to build dams and other structures, for the purpose of conservation of Atlantic sea run salmon, provided prior rights of towns are not affected thereby.'

#### Chapter 316

AN ACT Classifying Certain Tidewaters in Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 79, § 15, amended. Section 15 of chapter 79 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended under the caption "Lincoln County from the Town Line Between Edgecomb and Boothbay to the Knox County Boundary," by adding after subsection XVII, the following subsections:

'XVIII. All tidal waters within the Town of Alna-Class SB-1.

XIX. All tidal waters bordering the westerly shoreline of the Town of Edgecomb-Class SB-1.

XX. All tidal waters bordering the westerly shoreline of the Town of New-castle-Class SB-1.

XXI. All tidal waters within the Town of Westport-Class SB-1.

XXII. All tidal waters within the Town of Wiscasset-Class SB-1.
