CHAP. 55

#### Chapter 54

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in St. Croix River, Washington County.

Fishing in St. Croix River, regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the St. Croix River from the dam in Woodland to the dam at the outlet of Spednik Lake in Vanceboro to fishing for all fish except salmon, trout and togue from September 16th to October 31st under the general laws.
