Chapter 56

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Certain Waters in Washington County.

Certain waters in Washington County; fishing regulated. Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game be authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation opening the following lakes and ponds in Washington County, to fishing for all fish except trout, salmon and togue from October 1st to October 31st of each year:

Resolved: That the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game is authorized and directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all fishing that portion of Fowler Brook in Benton from the road culvert on the Unity Road (Route 139) to its confluence with the Sebasticook River.

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Maine Defense Commission to Convey Certain Land in Presque Isle.

Maine Defense Commission authorized to convey certain land. Resolved: That the Maine Defense Commission is authorized and directed to convey by quitclaim deed to the City of Presque Isle, the interest of the State in a certain piece or parcel of land on the easterly side of the U. S. Highway No. 1, so called,
