Chapter 166

AN ACT Relating to Sale of Liquor by Social Clubs to Members of Same National or Affiliated International Organizations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 805, amended. Section 805 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘§ 805. Clubs; registers, sales to nonmembers

Every club shall keep and maintain a register which shall disclose the name, identity and address of each member of the club and shall be open for inspection at all reasonable times to any inspector or other authorized agent of the commission. Licensed clubs shall not sell liquor except to members and their guests accompanying them, except that veterans' and fraternal organizations and social clubs duly licensed may sell liquor to members of the same national or affiliated international organization and to members of auxiliaries of the same national or affiliated international organization and their guests accompanying them.’

Chapter 167

AN ACT Providing for Inventory of Legislative Property by Legislative Research Committee.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 3, § 42, amended. The 4th sentence of section 42 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

‘A perpetual inventory of all legislative property shall be maintained under the supervision of the Legislative Research Committee and an accounting thereof shall be made to the Legislature upon its request.’

Chapter 168

AN ACT Relating to Closing County Roads for Maintenance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 2051, amended. Section 2051 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

‘§ 2051. Power of commissioners

County commissioners may lay out, alter, close for maintenance or discontinue highways leading from town to town and grade hills in any such highway. The
