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~~February~~ January 15th the manager and the superintendent of schools shall present to the budget committee the final statement of receipts and expenditures for the fiscal year just completed. The budget committee shall hold such additional meetings as it may deem necessary for proper consideration of the town's services and finances. Not later than February 25 the committee shall hold its final meeting and make specific recommendations to be presented to the annual town meeting on all articles in the warrant of said meeting calling for appropriations, and shall appoint one of its members to explain at the town meeting its recommendations and the reasons therefor.'

## Chapter 117

### AN ACT Relating to Sick Leave Benefits for Employees of the Department of Public Works of the City of Lewiston.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

P. & S. L., 1939, c. 8, Art. X, § 4-A, amended. The first sentence of section 4-A of article X of chapter 8 of the private and special laws of 1939, as enacted by chapter 140 of the private and special laws of 1957, is amended to read as follows:

'Employees of the department of public works shall be allowed to accumulate one day of sick leave for every ~~30 days~~ month worked, a total of 12 days per year, accumulating to ~~50~~ 70 days.'

## Chapter 118

### AN ACT to Incorporate the Abby Finance Company.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

**Sec. 1. Corporators; corporate name; powers and privileges.** Lionel Bisson of Lewiston, in the County of Androscoggin and State of Maine; Cecile Bisson of Lewiston, in the County of Androscoggin and State of Maine; and Margarete Clark of Lewiston, in the County of Androscoggin and State of Maine, or such of them as may vote to accept this charter, with their associates, successors and assigns, are hereby made a body corporate to be known as the "Abby Finance Company" and as such shall have the power to enact suitable bylaws and regulations, and elect such officers as it deems desirable to effect its corporate purposes and to be possessed of all the powers, privileges and immunities and subject to all the duties and obligations conferred on corporations by the general corporation law of this State.

**Sec. 2. Principal office.** The principal office and place of business in Maine is to be located in the City of Lewiston, County of Androscoggin, or as fixed by the directors, and the corporation may establish branch offices.
