- Sec. 3. Unclassified employees not subject to Governor and Council determination. With respect to unclassified employees whose wage rates are not subject to determination by the Governor and Council, the authorities responsible for determining the wage rate of such employees are requested to consider such similar and equitable treatment as they may conclude is appropriate.
- Sec. 4. Utilization by other funds. Wages of employees in departments supported by the Highway Fund, Special Revenue Funds or other funds shall not be adjusted from moneys provided for the General Fund Pay Plan, but may be adjusted from funds available to the department from other sources.
- Sec. 5. Intent. It is the intent of the Legislature to adjust the ranges of the state salary schedule to reflect competitive wages now being paid by commerce and industry throughout the State of Maine.

Chapter 175

AN ACT Providing for New Ferry Landing at Forest City Landing, Peaks Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Construction. The Maine Port Authority is authorized and directed to construct a new ferry landing for the movement of vehicles at Forest City Landing, Peaks Island.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Maine Port Authority the sum of \$70,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 to carry out the purposes of this Act.
- Sec. 3. Operational and maintenance costs. Annual rental shall be paid to the State of Maine. Operational and maintenance costs will be paid for under lease contract by Casco Bay Lines.

Chapter 176

AN ACT Appropriating Moneys for Dredging Project at New Harbor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Dredging project at New Harbor; appropriation. There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund to the Town of Bristol the sum of \$4,000, to aid said town for a dredging project at New Harbor. Such appropriation shall not be available until a like amount has been appropriated by the Town of Bristol for the same purpose.
