Chapter 231

AN ACT Relating to the Staff of Vocational Rehabilitation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Utilizing funds made available by Federal Government. In order to utilize funds made available by the Federal Government for vocational rehabilitation, the Department of Education, Vocational Rehabilitation Division, is authorized to increase its staff as follows:

Chapter 232

AN ACT Relating to the State Valuation Used in the Educational Subsidy Computation for the Town of Dedham.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, the 102nd Legislature adopted a uniform local effort method of computing subsidy; and

Whereas, the Town of Dedham received special dispensation through the enactment of chapter 198 of the private and special laws of 1949; and

Whereas, such legislation gives an unfair financial advantage to the Town of Dedham; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine, and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1949, c. 198, repealed. Chapter 198 of the private and special laws of 1949 is repealed.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
