CHAP. 85

Administrative District No. 3, as provided in the Revised Statutes, Title 20, section 222, is hereby discharged.

Effective September 3, 1965

#### Chapter 83

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Raymond A. Cote of Augusta for Legal Expenses for Securing Right of Appeal to Superior Court.

Raymond A. Cote; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$2,000 to be paid to Raymond A. Cote of Augusta as reimbursement for his legal expenses in securing the right of appeal to the Superior Court from the decision of the State Personnel Board confirming his dismissal as an employee of the Department of Economic Development.

#### Chapter 84

RESOLVE, Authorizing the Establishment of a Residential and Day School for the Mentally Retarded in Northern Maine.

Residential and day school for the mentally retarded in Northern Maine. Resolved: There is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$33,133 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1967 for the purpose of establishing and operating a residential and day school, under the supervision of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections for the provision of education and training for the mentally retarded according to the following schedule:

#### Chapter 85

RESOLVE, in Favor of Development of State Park on Lower Range Pond, Poland, Androscoggin County.

State Park on Lower Range Pond; appropriation for. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the

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sum of \$25,000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1966 for the development and construction of a state park on Lower Range Pond. Such expenditures will be expended by and under the supervision of the Maine State Park and Recreation Commission with the approval of the Governor and Council.
