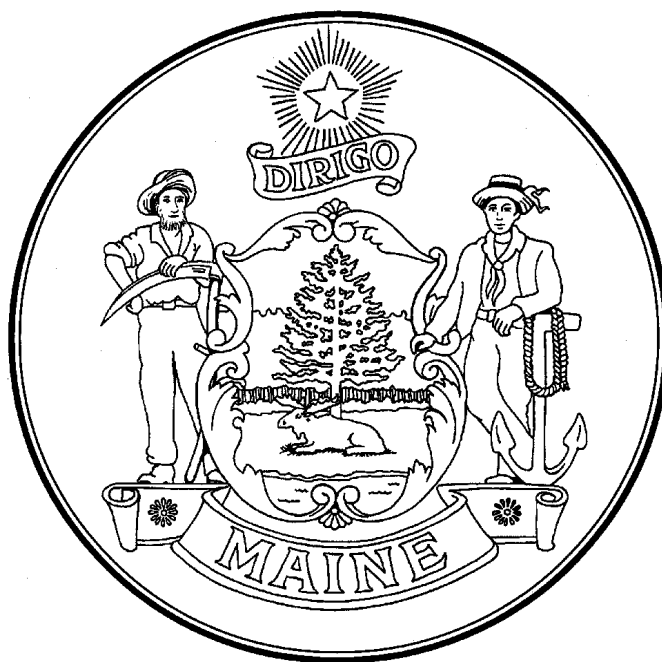

Chapter 96

RESOLVE, Providing for a Maine Key Number Digest.

Contract. Resolved: That the Attorney General contract for the publication of and purchasing in the name of the State of Maine of a Key Number Digest which shall contain a comprehensive digest of the opinions of the Supreme Judicial Court of Maine, and such other editorial features and research aids as the Attorney General may deem appropriate; and be it further

Resolved: That the Attorney General shall cause 300 copies of the Maine Key Number Digest to be printed and bound to be distributed to the various state agencies under the direction of the State Librarian; and be it further

Resolved: That the sum of \$48,600 be appropriated from the General Fund to carry out the purposes of this resolve, and the unexpended balance shall not lapse but shall remain a continuing carrying account until June 30, 1967. The breakdown to be as follows:

Chapter 97

RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds for Constructing a Day School for the Mentally Retarded in Northern Maine.

Appropriation. Resolved: There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Aroostook Association for Retarded Children, a nonprofit corporation, the sum of \$73,500. Said funds shall be used for the construction of a day school. Available federal matching funds shall be utilized. The breakdown of expenditure shall be as follows:
