**Chapter 1**

**AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Otter.**

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

**R. S., T. 12, § 2358, sub-§ 1, amended.** The 4th paragraph of subsection one of section 2358 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as revised, is amended as follows:

The open season on otter shall be the months of November, ~~December and January~~ and ~~February~~ of each calendar year.

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**Chapter 2**

**AN ACT Relating to Membership in Advisory Committee of Highway Safety and Change of Name of Executive Secretary.**

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

**Sec. 1. R. S., T. 23, § 104, amended.** The first sentence of section 104 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The heads of the following state departments and agencies or their designated representatives shall constitute an Advisory Committee of State Officials: Attorney General, Secretary of State, Education, Highway Commission, State Police, Public Utilities Commission, **Commissioner of Health and Welfare, Commissioner of Labor and Industry.**

**Sec. 2. R. S., T. 23, § 105, amended.** Section 105 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
