Chapter 152

AN ACT Relating to Area Directional Sign for China Lake Region.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1201, sub-§ 10-A, additional. Section 1201 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 10-A, to read as follows:

10-A. China Lake Region: Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on Interstate 95;

Chapter 153

AN ACT Reclassifying Certain Tidal Waters of Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 38, § 370, amended. Subsection 10, paragraphs A, B, C and D, of section 370 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, under the caption **Tidal Waters, Hancock County**, are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

10. Hancock.

A. Tidewaters of Hancock north and westerly of a line drawn due west from Pecks Point in waters known as Kilkenney Cove, Skillins River and Youngs Bay—Class SB-2.

B. Tidewater from Pecks Point southeasterly and in a counterclockwise direction to a point of land just south of Jellison Cove at latitude $44^{\circ} - 29.2'$ (approximately)—Class SC.

C. Tidewaters of Town of Hancock not otherwise specified or described—Class SB-1.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 38, § 370, amended. Subsection 11, paragraphs A and B, of section 370 of Title 38 of the Revised Statutes, under the caption **Tidal Waters, Hancock County**, are amended to read as follows:

A. Tidewaters from the Hancock-Lamoine town line at Kilkenney Cove south to a point at $N44^{\circ} - 31.25' W68^{\circ} - 48.25'$ line drawn due west from Pecks Point in the Town of Hancock—Class ~~SC~~ SB-2.

B. Tidewaters within the Town of Lamoine not otherwise specified or classified—Class ~~SC~~ SB-1.

Effective October 7, 1967
