Chapter 172

AN ACT Relating to Notice of Removal of Name from the Voting List.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 172, amended. The first paragraph of section 172 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The registrar shall send a notice by certified mail with return receipt requested to the last known place of residence of each living person whose name he or she has removed from the voting list. Upon receipt of such notification the voter shall reply to the registrar within 60 days stating his reasons why his name should not be removed from the voting list. If this notification is returned unclaimed, such return shall be deemed sufficient notice to make the removal of such name confirmed. Such return receipts and replies by the voter to the registrar shall be kept on file by the registrar and available for inspection for 2 years.

Chapter 173

AN ACT Relating to Use of Interest of Organized Townships Fund by Lakeville Plantation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 4166, amended. Section 4166 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 67 of chapter 226 of the public laws of 1965, is further amended by adding at the end thereof, the following paragraph.

The amount due Lakeville Plantation, Penobscot County, annually under this section shall be expended in accordance with this section and any excess shall, under the supervision and direction of the superintending school committee of Lakeville Plantation, be used to establish scholarship aid for students of Lakeville Plantation to receive post high school education.

Chapter 174

AN ACT Relating to Removal of Motor Vehicles Parked Illegally on Highways and Highway Rights-of-Way.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1111, amended. The last paragraph of section 1111 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:
