Chapter 26

AN ACT to Repeal and Amend Certain Private and Special Laws Relative to Sea and Shore Fisheries.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1959, c. 154, Chapter E, repealed. Chapter E of chapter 154 of the private and special laws of 1959 is repealed.

Sec. 2. P. & S. L., 1959, c. 155, § 71, amended. Section 71 of chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959 is amended by adding at the end, a new paragraph, as follows:

This section does not apply to the taking of alewives under authority of section 63, nor to the taking of alewives under the authority of any other law.

Sec. 3. P. & S. L., 1959, c. 155, §§ 118, 119, repealed. Sections 118 and 119 of chapter 155 of the private and special laws of 1959 are repealed.

Chapter 27

AN ACT Relating to Legislative Apportionment for Cranberry Isles, Hancock County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. & S. L., 1963, c. 233, § 1, amended. That part of section 1 of chapter 233 of the private and special laws of 1963 which relates to Hancock County is amended to read as follows:

The County of Hancock shall choose 5 Representatives to be apportioned as follows: Brooklin, Brooksville, Castine, ~~Cranberry Isles~~ Deer Isle, Sedgwick, Stonington, Swan's Island and Long Island Plantation, one Representative; Bucksport, Dedham, Orland, Penobscot and Verona, one Representative; Blue Hill, Ellsworth and Surry, one Representative; Bar Harbor, **Cranberry Isles**, Mount Desert, Southwest Harbor and Tremont, one Representative; Amherst, Aurora, Eastbrook, Franklin, Gouldsboro, Hancock, Lamoine, Mariaville, Otis, Sorrento, Sullivan, Trenton, Waltham, Winter Harbor, Osborn Plantation, No. 33 Plantation and all Unorganized Townships, one Representative.
