Chapter 71

AN ACT Authorizing Additional Staff Within Eye Care and Special Services Division, Department of Health and Welfare.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Eye Care and Special Services Division; additional staff. In order to utilize funds made available by the Federal Government for its vocational rehabilitation program, the Division of Eye Care and Special Services, Department of Health and Welfare, is authorized to increase its staff as follows:

Chapter 72

AN ACT Relating to Incorporation of Maine World Trade Council.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Maine World Trade Council; authorized to use same name. The Maine World Trade Council is granted the authority to use the same name whenever it incorporates under the general law as a nonprofit organization.

Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become null and void unless the incorporation is organized within 18 months after the effective date of this Act.

Chapter 73

AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Union Mutual Life Insurance Company.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1878, c. 74, § 1, amended. Section 1 of chapter 74 of the private and special laws of 1878 is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. Corporators; corporate name; powers and privileges. Joseph H. Williams, E. Brown Pratt and J. Walker Judd, their associates and successors, and all others who may hereafter become members of this company, as hereinafter provided, are hereby constituted a body corporate, by the name of the Union
