Chapter 32

RESOLVE, Designating Certain Bridges of the Interstate System Across the Penobscot River as "Vaughan M. Daggett Memorial Bridges."

Designation of certain bridges of Interstate Highway System. Resolved: That in recognition of the outstanding and unselfish service rendered to the State of Maine by the late Vaughan M. Daggett the bridges on the Interstate Highway System in Maine across the Penobscot River in the Town of Medway be named the "Vaughan M. Daggett Memorial Bridges"; and be it further

Resolved: That appropriate plaques designating the name of these bridges be maintained by the State Highway Commission at such locations on the approaches to or on the bridges themselves as the State Highway Commission may select; and be it further

Resolves, 1959, c. 54, repealed and replaced. Resolved: That chapter 54 of the resolves of 1959, as amended, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Designation of Interstate Highway System. Resolved: That in recognition of the outstanding and unselfish service rendered by the late Brian M. Jewett to the State of Maine that the Interstate Highway System in Maine, except for the bridges across the Kennebec River from Fairfield to Benton and except for the bridges across the Penobscot River in the Town of Medway and except for the other bridges from Stillwater to Houlton and except for the Maine Turnpike from the Kittery Entrance to the Gardiner Interchange and the bridge across the Piscataqua River from Kittery to Portsmouth, New Hampshire, be named the "Brian M. Jewett Memorial Highway" and that appropriate plaques designating the name of the highway be erected and maintained by the State Highway Commission at such locations in rest areas as the State Highway Commission shall select.

Chapter 33

RESOLVE, Permitting Augusta Golf Company to Draw Water from Lake Cobbosseecontee.

Augusta Golf Company permitted to draw water from Lake Cobbosseecontee. Resolved: That the Augusta Golf Company, its successors or assigns, be permitted to draw water from Lake Cobbosseecontee, a great pond, on which the said Augusta Golf Company borders, for the specific purpose of watering a golf course.
