Chapter 74

RESOLVE, Reimbursing Certain Municipalities on Account of Property Tax Exemptions of Veterans.

Reimbursements to be paid to certain municipalities. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$289,190.56 to pay the following claims presented by municipalities for taxes for the years 1965 and 1966 lost by reason of exemption of veterans, in accordance with the provisions of the Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 653, subsection 1, paragraph H:

Chapter 75

RESOLVE, Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Insuring Payment of Industrial Loans to Fisheries and Agriculture.

Constitutional amendment. Resolved: Two-thirds of each branch of the Legislature concurring, that the following amendment to the Constitution of this State be proposed:

Constitution, Article IX, Section 14-A, amended. Section 14-A of Article IX of the Constitution, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

Section 14-A. Permits insuring payment of industrial, fisheries and agricultural loans secured by real estate and personal property by legislative Act. For the purposes of fostering, encouraging and assisting the physical location, settlement and resettlement of industrial and manufacturing enterprises and fostering
