Chapter 1

AN ACT Relating to Closed Season on Wild Hares in Lincoln County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2356, amended. Section 2356 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph, a new paragraph, as follows:

It shall be unlawful to hunt wild hares or rabbits in the County of Lincoln with dogs during the open season on deer.

Effective October 1, 1969

Chapter 2

AN ACT Relating to Enforcement of Real Estate Taxes in Unorganized Territory.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 36, § 1281, amended. Section 1281 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as last amended by section 7 of chapter 271 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

§ 1281. Payment of taxes; delinquent taxes; publication;
certificate filed in registry

State, county and forestry district taxes on real estate mentioned in section 1141 shall be paid on or before the first day of October following the date of assessment and such taxes shall be delinquent on the first day of February of
