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## Chapter 105

### AN ACT Regulating Atlantic Salmon Fishing in Maine Rivers.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., T. 12, § 2552, sub-§ 7, additional. Section 2552 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 7, to read as follows:

7. Atlantic salmon. There shall be an open season for Atlantic salmon as follows:

A. Dennys River — That portion of the Dennys River between tidewater and 2 red posts at The Narrows in the Town of Dennysville, Washington County, shall be open to fly fishing until October 15th.

B. Machias River — That portion of the Machias River between tidewater and the Whitneyville Dam in the Town of Whitneyville, Washington County, shall be open to fly fishing until October 15th.

C. Narraguagus River — That portion of the Narraguagus River between tidewater and the Cherryfield Ice Control Dam in the Town of Cherryfield, Washington County, shall be open to fly fishing until October 15th.

Effective October 1, 1969

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## Chapter 106

### AN ACT Relating to the Chairman of the State Apprenticeship Council.

*Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:*

R. S., T. 26, § 1002, amended. The 4th sentence of section 1002 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The chairman and secretary of the council shall be named by the members of the council ~~the chairman coming from the group which represents the public~~ and the chairman shall be a member of the council.
