Chapter 107

AN ACT Repealing Law Providing for **Economic** and Recreational Development in Oxford County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 10, § 911, repealed. Section 911 of Title 10 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 122 of the public laws of 1965 and amended by sections 1 and 2 of chapter 442 of the public laws of 1967; is repealed.

Effective October 1, 1969

Chapter 108

AN ACT Relating to Inspection of Motorcycles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2122, amended. The last sentence of the 4th paragraph of section 2122 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

Said inspection shall not apply to motorcycles.

Chapter 109 AN ACT Relating to the Preparation of Voting Lists.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., T. 21, § 171, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 171 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
- I. List prepared. He shall prepare a printed or typewritten list, alphabetically by surname, of all the voters of the municipality. He shall add the street address of each voter beside his name and mailing address. In a municipality which has voting districts, he shall make a separate list for each district and shall add the street address of each voter beside his name.
- Sec. 2. R. S., T. 21, § 201, sub-§ 1, ¶ B, amended. Paragraph B of subsection 1 of section 201 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:
 - B. Street address and mailing address.
 - Sec. 3. Effective date. This Act shall take effect on April 1, 1970.
