be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, both municipal and private, operating a wastewater treatment plant to operate same unless the competency of the operator only is certified to by the commission under this chapter. It shall be unlawful for any person to perform the duties of an operator, as defined, without being duly certified under this chapter.

§ 4182. Violation of law or rules and regulations

Any person, firm or corporation, both municipal and private, violating any provision of this chapter or the rules and regulations adopted thereunder is guilty of a misdemeanor. Each day of operation in violation of this chapter or any rules and regulations adopted thereunder shall constitute a separate offense.

Chapter 238

AN ACT Relating to Legislative Finance Office as Secretariat for Commission on Intergovernmental Relations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 3, § 273, amended. The 2nd sentence of section 273 of Title 3 of the Revised Statutes is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The office of the Legislative Finance Officer shall serve as the secretariat of the commission.

Chapter 239

AN ACT to Allow Interstate Commerce of Rifles and Shotguns Between Contiguous States.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, c. 254, additional. Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new chapter 254, to read as follows:

CHAPTER 254

PURCHASE OF WEAPONS

§ 2041. Purchase by Maine residents in another state

Residents of the State may purchase rifles and shotguns in a state contiguous to the State of Maine, provided that such residents conform to the applicable provisions of the Gun Control Act of 1968, and regulations thereunder, as administered by the United States Secretary of the Treasury, and provided further that such residents conform to the law applicable to such purchase in the State of Maine and in the contiguous state in which the purchase is made.

§ 2042. Purchase by nonresidents in Maine

Residents of a state contiguous to the State of Maine may purchase rifles and shotguns in the State of Maine, provided that such residents conform to the applicable provisions of the Gun Control Act of 1968, and regulations thereunder, as administered by the United States Secretary of the Treasury, and provided further that such residents conform to the law applicable to such purchase in the State of Maine and in the state in which such persons reside.

Chapter 240

AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Partridge or Grouse and Pheasant.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 2352, amended. The 2nd paragraph of section 2352 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

There shall be a closed season on partridge or grouse ~~and pheasant~~ from November 16th to September 30th of the following year. ~~There shall be a closed season on pheasant from December 1st to September 30th of the following year.~~ No person shall at any time buy or sell any partridge, grouse or pheasant. No person shall have in possession any partridge or pheasants taken in closed season.
