Chapter 517

AN ACT Relating to Fees of Certain Corporations Payable to Secretary of State.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves passed by the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Section 2 of Chapter 132 of the Public Laws of 1969 inadvertently repealed the authority of the Secretary of State to collect certain fees; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 5, § 86, amended. The 5th paragraph of section 86 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 132 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

For receiving, filing and recording copy of certificate of organization of a corporation organized under Title ~~24-A~~ 13, chapters 1 to 21, \$5 in advance.

Sec. 2. R. S., T. 5, § 86, amended. The 8th paragraph of section 86 of Title 5 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 2 of chapter 132 of the public laws of 1969, is further amended to read as follows:

For filing power of attorney of a foreign corporation under Title ~~24-A~~ 13, section 591, \$10; for filing instrument revoking such power of attorney, \$5; for filing copy of charter under Title ~~24-A~~ 13, section 592, \$10 additional; for filing certificate of increase or reduction of stock of a foreign corporation, \$10.

Sec. 3. R. S., T. 13, § 600, repealed. Section 600 of Title 13 of the Revised Statutes is repealed as follows:

~~§ 600. Charitable organization exempt from fees~~

~~Foreign charitable corporations shall be exempt from the payment of any fees payable by foreign corporations to the Secretary of State~~

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.
